

**MINUTES OF THE  
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
BRADFORD COUNTY, FLORIDA  
PUBLIC HEARING TO

The Bradford County Board of County Commissioners convened in a public hearing on Tuesday, October 3, 2006, at 5:15 p.m. in the County Commissioners' Meeting Room, 945 North Temple Avenue, Starke, Florida.

Present were: Commissioner Lewis, Commissioner Thomas, Chairman Hersey and Commissioner Cooper. (Commissioner Chandler was unable to attend.)

Also present were: Jim Crawford, County Manager; June Neats, Administrative Assistant; Jim Farrell, Finance Director; Marlene Stafford, Deputy Clerk and Mark Crawford, Press.

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**CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Hersey called the public hearing to order at 5:15 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to adopt a resolution amending the Fiscal-Year 2005-2006 Budget.

Chairman Hersey opened the public hearing. There being no response, the public hearing was closed.

Chairman Hersey read the title into the record:

***“A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BRADFORD COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO ITS BUDGET FOR THE 2005-2006 FISCAL YEAR; AMENDING REVENUES, APPROPRIATIONS AND USE OF FUND BALANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.”***

*On Motion of Commissioner Thomas, Seconded by Commissioner Lewis, the Board voted 4-0 to adopt the Resolution Amending the Fiscal-Year 2005-2006 Budget.

**“A RESOLUTION OF THE BRADFORD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPROVING A \$248,365.00 INCREASE IN REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES IN THE SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT.”**

*On Motion of Commissioner Lewis, Seconded by Commissioner Thomas, the Board voted 4-0 to adopt the resolution as presented. (The [Resolution was assigned No. 06-27.](#))*

**“A RESOLUTION OF THE BRADFORD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPROVING A \$199,303.00 INCREASE IN REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES IN THE ROAD DEPARTMENT FUND.”**

*On Motion of Commissioner Thomas, Seconded by Commissioner Cooper, the Board voted 4-0 to adopt the resolution as presented. (The [Resolution was assigned No. 06-28.](#))*

**“A RESOLUTION OF THE BRADFORD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPROVING A \$163,481.00 INCREASE IN REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES IN THE FISCALLY CONSTRAINED FUND.”**

**WORKSHOP  
PROPOSED COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT  
DCA NO. 07-1ER (CPA 03-1)  
5:30 P.M.**

The Bradford County Board of County Commissioners convened in a workshop session on Tuesday, October 3, 2006, at 5:30 p.m. in the County Commissioners' Meeting Room, 945 North Temple Avenue, Starke, Florida.

Present were: Commissioner Lewis, Commissioner Thomas, Chairman Hersey and Commissioner Cooper. (Commissioner Chandler was unable to attend.)

Also present were: Jim Crawford, County Manager; June Neats, Administrative Assistant; Marlene Stafford, Deputy Clerk; Nora Thompson, Zoning Director; Enid Ehrbar, North Central Florida Regional Planning Council and Mark Crawford, Press.

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**CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Hersey called the workshop to order at 5:30 p.m. The purpose of the workshop is to discuss the [Florida Department of Community Affairs' Objections, Recommendations and Comments regarding Proposed Comprehensive Plan Amendment DCA No. 07-1ER \(CPA 03-1\)](#).

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**DISCUSSION**

Ms. Ehrbar said that the Camp Blanding issue is one of a number of work responses. If the Commission is comfortable with those, there will be no need to discuss them. Most of them are perfunctory with the exception of one other item of substance, which can be discussed following the Camp Blanding issue.

At the request of Commissioner Cooper, Ms. Ehrbar reviewed local government statutory obligations concerning military installations outlined in Chapter 163 of the Florida Statutes.

Extensive discussion resulted concerning the verbiage of the various Policies within the Objections, Recommendations and Comments prepared by DCA. The discussion was not limited to but included: Compatibility, buffer zone, development restrictions, building heights and communications towers, lighting standards, urban service area and aviation easements.

The Commission instructed Ms. Ehrbar to make certain verbiage changes to the various policies within the Comprehensive Plan Amendment.

Ms. Ehrbar said that she would prepare the language and get it to the Commission prior to the public hearing scheduled for October 19. There is a high probability that DCA will take issue with the proposed language and hold the County in non-compliance.
