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The Bradford County Board of County Commissioners convened in a Special Called Meeting on Thursday, April 24, 2014, at 11:30 a.m. in the County Commission Chambers at 945 North Temple Avenue, Starke, Florida, to consider adoption of a resolution initiating local government conflict resolution procedures pursuant to Chapter 164, F.S., regarding annexation of certain real property by the City of Starke.

**PRESENT:** Chairman Riddick, Commissioner Sellars, Commissioner Chandler, Commissioner Thomas, and Commissioner Lewis.

**ALSO PRESENT:** Brad Carter, County Manager; Rachel Rhoden, Deputy County Manager; Will Sexton, County Attorney; Marlene Stafford, Deputy Clerk; and Sheriff Smith.

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**CALL TO ORDER:** Chairman Riddick called the meeting to order at 11:37 a.m.

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**RESOLUTION:**

**--INITIATING LOCAL GOVERNMENT CONFLICT RESOLUTION PROCEDURES  
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 164, F.S., REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN REAL  
PROPERTY BY THE CITY OF STARKE--WILL SEXTON:**

Chairman Riddick called for public comments. There were none.

Mr. Sexton presented the resolution for consideration. The resolution was initiated based on concerns raised by the Sheriff relating to annexations by the City of Starke. The Legislature adopted F.S. 164 for disputes between government entities, which require adoption of a resolution in order to initiate intergovernmental conflict resolution procedures.

Mr. Sexton advised that the City of Starke would receive a copy of the adopted resolution, suggesting a conflict assessment meeting with staff from both entities. If no solution can be reached at that meeting, statute then requires a joint meeting of the two Boards. Should the two Boards be unable to work out a solution, then the door is open for other options available to the parties.

Mr. Sexton read the title of the resolution into the record.

*Commissioner Lewis moved, seconded by Commissioner Chandler, and carried 5-0, to adopt the Resolution as presented.* (The Resolution was assigned No. 2014-001.)

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Incited by inquiry of Commissioner Chandler and with Board consensus, Mr. Sexton advised that the letter to the City of Starke would include a recommendation that the staff meeting be held in the County Commission chambers; other meetings can be alternated between to the two entities.

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**ADJOURN:**

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 11:42 a.m.
