PUBLIC NOTICE

BRADFORD COUNTY SENIOR CENTER

The Bradford County Senior Center located at 1805 N. Temple Avenue, Starke, Florida will continue to remain temporarily closed until further notice. The Senior Center has been closed since March 18, 2020. The most current information that we have received from officials, including the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and State of Florida public health and emergency management officials indicates that the continued transmission of COVID-19 represents a significant risk of health - especially to those at great risk of serious complications from COVID-19, including individuals 60 years old and older as well as those individuals with underlying medical conditions. We have received direction that efforts should be made to limit gatherings of people, the time in which people interact, and unnecessary face-to-face interactions.

These are unprecedented times and Bradford County is attempting to manage the COVID-19 pandemic to the best of our ability based on guidance and best practices received from State officials. We will continue to monitor the situation and keep the community informed of updates concerning operations of the Senior Center.

While the Senior Center remains temporarily closed for recreational activities, the Florida Department of Health in Bradford County will utilize the Senior Center facility for COVID-19 testing and investigations that is scheduled to begin mid-July and could continue until December.
